The *Numb3rs* star (and mom-to-be!) shows *Life & Style* the new nursery in her LA home

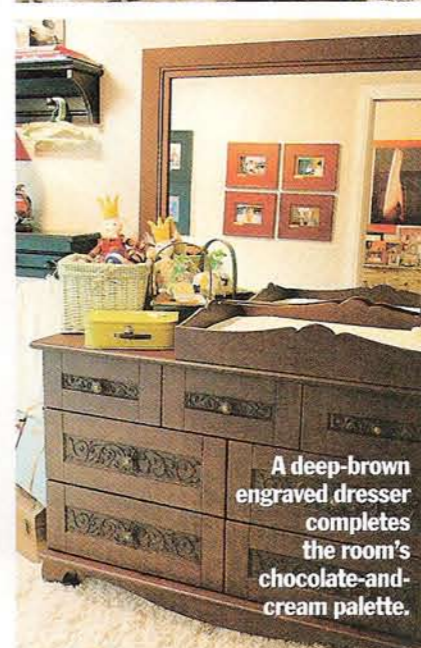

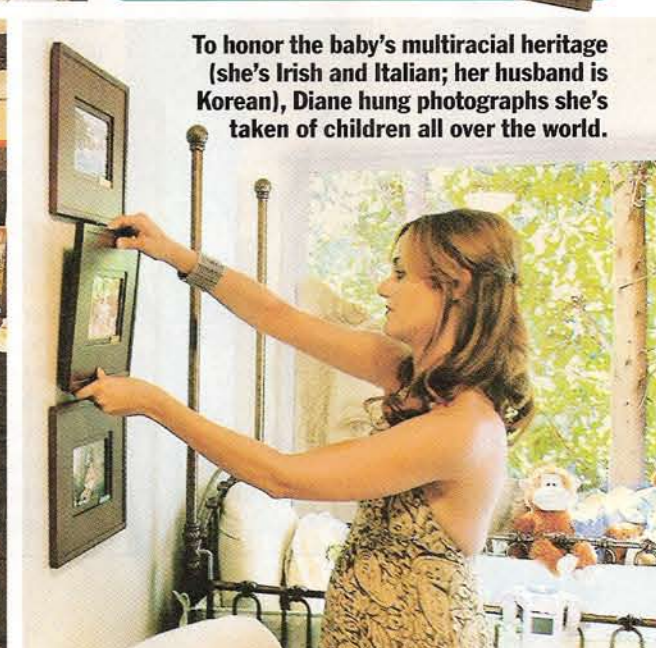

"These dolls are from the Netherlands — you can't tell if they're boys or girls or what race they are," says Diane.

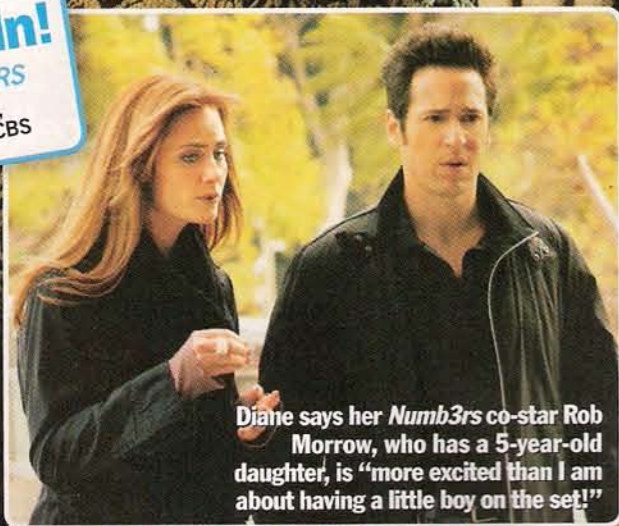


A deep-brown engraved dresser completes the room's chocolate-and-cream palette.
